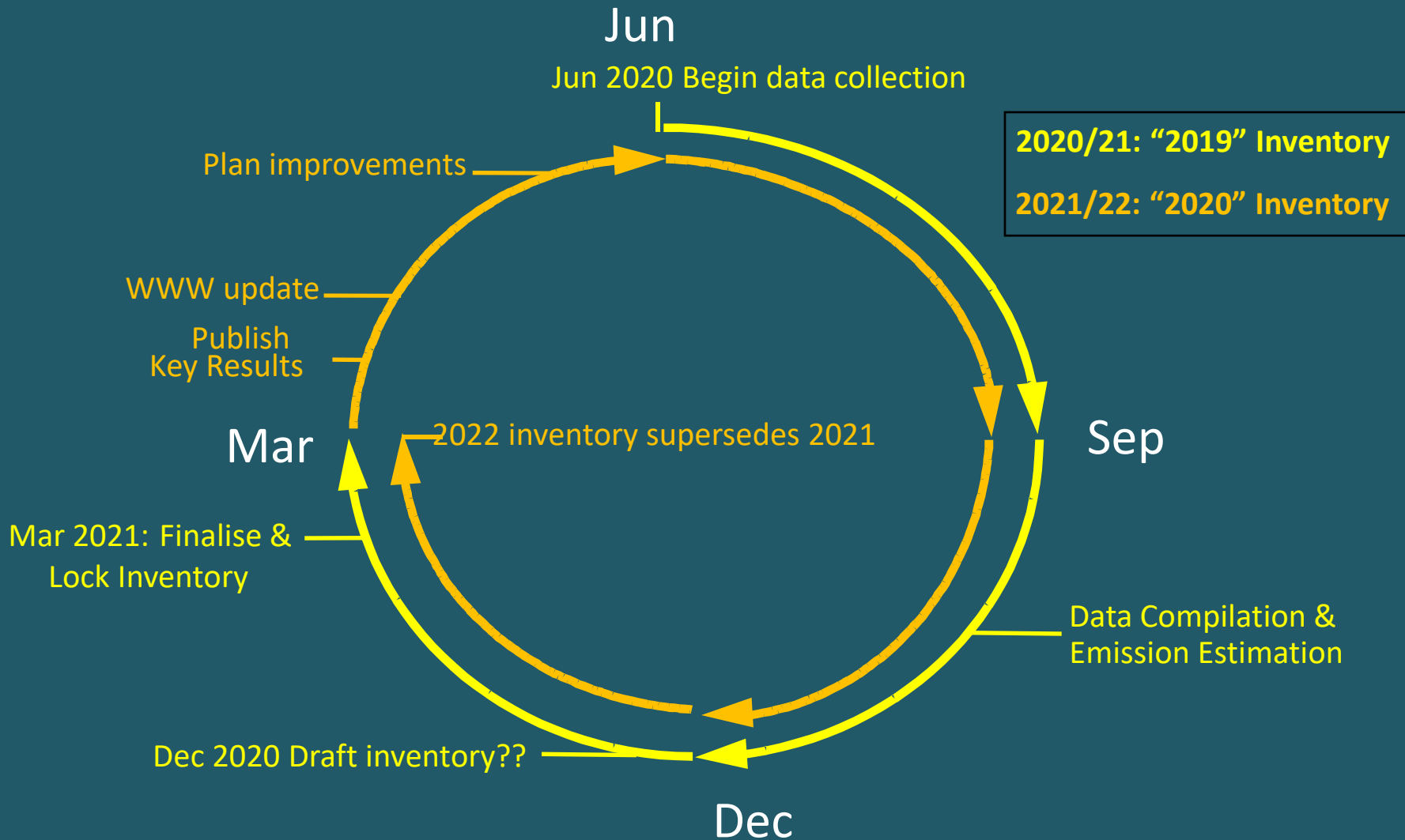

# Organise your annual cycle



# Organise your funding/resources



- Be realistic about how much work is involved
- ... now, and next year, and the year after that...
- No funds for an improvement programme?
- ... your inventory will be useless in a few years
- Start with a focus on reporting
- ... but your aim is to support policy formation
- You need high level co-ordination & support across Ministries/Departments etc.

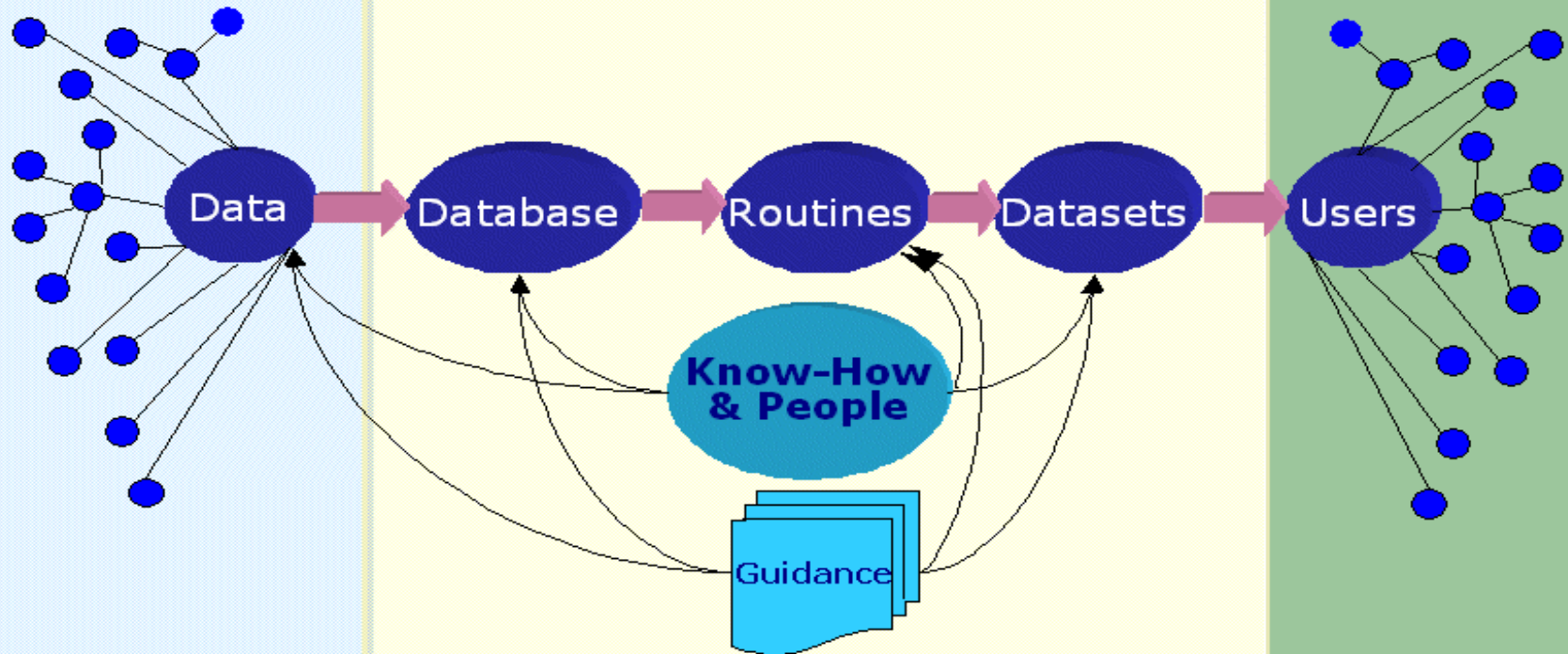

# Quality metrics



- **Transparency**
  - Informative inventory report
- **Completeness**
  - Methodologies in the EMEP/EEA Guidebook
- **Consistency (“internal”)**
- **Comparability (“external”)**
  - NFR reporting format
- **Accuracy**
  - Tier 2 methodologies for key sources

# Engage with CLRTAP reviews



- Someone will recommend where you need to improve your inventory... for free
- ... as long as you engage in the process
- You can't do everything straight away
- ... but improve the inventory year by year 😊
